
Checking Student Progress on PowerSchool

When you are logged into PowerSchool through the web-based platform (not the APP) you will see a screen like this. It shows all of your students' classes.



Viewing Information on this screen

- The column labelled "S1" will show information related to our first term
- The column labelled "S2" will show complementary courses offered in the second term
- The column labelled "Y1" shows the second half of the year for yearlong courses.

Viewing Assignments and Assessment Information:

To view assignments and assessment from now until the first report card, click the "info" button in the "S1" column. This will give you more information about the course you want to see. In this case, selecting "Info" beside Mathematics will show more details about a student's assignments in Math.

When you click the "info" button you will see a screen, similar to this one. It opens at the bottom of your window, so you may need to scroll down to see it.



Navigating This Screen



This example shows that the student has 4 assignments.

- 1. To see the grade indicators (1-4) for the assignment, click this blue drop-down box. If there are any outcomes with grades attached to this assignment, they will open below it.
- 2. The blue speech bubble means there is a comment with feedback on the student's work click "view" to read it. Your will see one or both of the following:
 - a. Description: This is the same for all students. It explains what students are being assessed on.
 - b. Comment: This is a comment specific to the student about how they did on the assignment. It explains what they are able to do, what they are working on, any accommodations or modifications, etc.
- 3. The icons show if the assignment has been submitted, if it's late, incomplete, etc. The checkmark in the green circle means that the assignment was handed in/completed.
